New structure for the conference

For a wider consultation of members and experts

- **Selection of the topic:**
 - VineLink members and conference participants
- **Study of the topic:**
 - *One Steering committee*
 - *Identification of different working group having one or two group leader(s)*
 - *Writting 2 questionnaires*
 - *Experts* : state of the art, work in progress, encountered problems, knowledge to be acquired, unknown or new experts, collaboration proposals, scientific papers of reference, etc.
 - *Professionals* : importance of the problem, current, possible and expected solutions, problems encountered with such solutions, technical papers of reference , etc.
 - *International inquiry*
- **Synthesis :**
 - *First Synthesis* : by group leaders
 - *Workshop* : with group leaders and selected experts to finalize and to share propositions and conclusions
- **Conclusions :**
 - *Conference* : Presentations of conclusions and propositions during the general assembly
 - *Others* : Join research programs (european, international), other possible collaboration, etc.

- **6 questionnaires**: Experts (4)and Professionnals (2)
- **Gathered answers**: more than 70 on more than 100 experts and professionals contacted
- **1 Steering Committee**: 21 members
- **Two workshops** : October, 23th, 2013 and February 13th, 2014
- **Conclusions** : focused on 4 working groups
